

## Report of Eagle Forum of California's 17th State Constitution Day Celebration September 23, 2017:

In honor of the 230<sup>th</sup> birthday of the U.S. Constitution, Eagle Forum of California held their annual state conference to celebrate the birth of the great founding document of our nation. The meeting was held at the Lomitas School House, 2421 Lomitas Ave., Santa Rosa, CA. from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with a potluck dinner and birthday cake at the end.

The opening prayer was given by Eagle Forum member and former Bishop Jan Van de Wetering of the LDS Church. The posting of the colors and flag salute was performed by the honor guard of Michael Ottilini AMVETS, Post 40 of Sonoma County. This was followed by a beautiful medley of patriotic music by the Children's Chorus under the direction of Heather Cullin.

Eagle Forum member and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President of the Republican Central Committee Debbie Leboy did an outstanding job as our M.C.



**Paul Preston was the first speaker.** He is a talk show host for Agenda 21 radio, which broadcasts two hours M-F and on Sunday afternoon on the internet. He is part of AENN, American Exceptional News Network <https://paulpreston21r.podbean.com/>. Paul is a former public-school science teacher and school administrator, who had two other radio shows dealing primarily with education. He began his present Agenda 21 radio show in 2012 and broadcasts from his home in Yuba City. He has amazing guests who help him stay abreast of what is going on in our state and nation. He spoke about the ***"Threats to our Constitution Coming from the State of California Itself" and told what we could do to remedy it.***



**Orlean Koehle spoke next.** She has been serving as the State President of Eagle Forum of California since 2002. In 2006 Orlean founded and served as the first president of the Sonoma County Land Rights Coalition which made her first aware of Agenda 21 and overbearing government regulations. She is a wife, mother, grandmother, former teacher, author of ten books, such as: *By Stealth and Deception; The Hidden Cs of Common Core; California's Water Crisis; America Needs Revival Not Revision.* She spoke on two topics – ***"The Threat of Islam and Sharia Law to Our Constitution and Why America and Our Constitution Needs Revival, not Revision."***



**Summer Boger was the third speaker.** She has been working as an HHP, a holistic health practitioner for 15 years in N.C. San Diego. She was honored twice by Senator Joel Anderson for her outstanding service in educating parents and students about health and wellness. She is also part of the Salt and Light Council and teaches classes on the Constitution. A mother of two children, she became concerned when California legislators were going to pass a mandatory vaccination bill SB 277 to take away parental rights concerning vaccinations. She became an activist and an expert. She spoke on ***"Why I am Opposed to Mandatory Vaccinations for Health and Freedom Reasons."***



**Double X was our fourth speaker.** He is a radio personality, host, producer, writer, speaker, award-winning filmmaker and pilot, U.S. military veteran, investigator, designer and entrepreneur based in Southern California. XX is a producer and frequent contributor to Pastor Ernie Sanders' Radio Ministry *"What's Right What's Left"* that reaches 38 States and 9 million listeners from WHKW in Cleveland. After years of sleuthing, XX located the original manuscript of George Washington's *"Farewell Address"* and seeks to rescue it and relocate it on prominent display next to the Constitution and Declaration of Independence. He spoke on ***Recovering Washington's Farewell Address and the Great Religious Truths Learned from It.***



**Diane Richards was our 5<sup>th</sup> Speaker.** She is Chairman for the Republican Central Committee for Trinity County, Editor and Publisher of the conservative monthly newsletter - *The Trinity Gazette*, and member of the Eagle Forum State Board, Director of Election Integrity. Diane has become an expert on election fraud which she experienced firsthand when she was a Supervisorial Candidate in the primary election in Trinity County in June of 2016. She told the amazing story of fraud, abuse of power, voters being disenfranchised, votes that were not counted, and, in spite of a ruling by an appellate court, judges who kept postponing the new trial and justice. Her talk was entitled ***"How Election Fraud is Destroying our Rights as Citizens and What We can do About it."***



**Debbie LeBoy** – was the last speaker. She is the former President of North Bay Patriots, where she often presented videos of the Constitution as part of each meeting. She is responsible for hundreds of copies of the Constitution being handed out at the Petaluma Veterans Parade and given to many elementary and middle schools in Rohnert Park, where she and her husband and teenage son reside. She serves as a member on the local Bond and Parcel Tax Oversight committees for her school district and regularly attends their meetings, where she recently spoke on the Constitution. She spoke on ***"Why I Love the Constitution and How to Impart that Love and Passion to our Youth."***

Orlean expressed appreciation to Debbie and to all the speakers, especially those who had traveled so far and to James and Barbara Bennett for the use of their lovely school house. She introduced Jennifer Delaney who ended the day with a song God Bless America. The closing prayer was given by Dr. Kurt Koehle.
