Dr. David Nicholas - President and Professor of Theology at Shasta Bible College. He received his MS degree from the University of Southern California, a Master of Theology from Talbot Theological Seminary and his Doctorate in Theology at Grace Theological Seminary, Winona Lake, IN. He has been part of Shasta Bible college since 1985. His topic: *“Why Religion and Morality are so Important in Preserving our Constitution.”*

Attorney Brad Dacus - Founder and President of the Pacific Justice Institute, a non-profit which specializes in the defense of religious freedom, parental rights, and other civil liberties. PJI has a network with hundreds of volunteer affiliate attorneys and handles more cases on the West Coast than any other organization of its kind. Brad has a weekly radio show called “The Dacus Report,” which goes out to 170 affiliate stations. He will be our M.C. and speaker and address: *“The Attack on Morality in our State Schools from the New Health Standards, and the Attack on our Religious Rights.”*



Phillip Drum – works as a Kaiser pharmacist in Martinez, CA. He has a Doctorate in Pharmacy from U.C. San Francisco. He has been active in various Pharmacy Associations and has spoken nationally on various pharmaceutical topics. He has also volunteered with the Veterans and the Homeless. After the death of his sister, killed by a driver high on marijuana, Phillip has become an active spokesperson against its legalization, which leads to so many other drugs. His topic: *The Attack on Morality from the Drug Culture.”*



June Gilliam – She was raised in Shanghai, China, where she attended a prestigious university and became an active member of the Communist Party. She came to America to advance her career. She now has an MBA and works for a Fortune 500 company in Silicon Valley. She slowly began to see the light of liberty and is now a Christian conservative. Her topic is: *“The Threat of Communism - the Dangerous Trends in America Today as Communism is Being Promoted Among our Youth.”*

Peter Friedman – Having had relatives who were killed in the holocaust under NAZI, Germany, Peter has become a scholar, expert, speaker on tyrannical forms of government, which includes Islam. He has also become a strong supporter of our 2nd Amendment rights as a way to prevent tyranny, and has been a firearm instructor and expert for over 50 years. He will speak on both subjects: *“The Threat of Islam and Sharia Law to our U.S. Constitution”* and *“Why We Must Preserve our Second Amendment Rights.”*



Orlean Koehle – has been serving as president of Eagle Forum of California State since 2002. She grew up on a farm in Idaho under a true free-enterprise system. As a teacher in the public schools for 20 years, she noticed growing myths and pseudo-science being taught under “environmental science,” which has resulted in enormous rules and regulations eroding away private property rights. To stand up against these over-bearing regulations, Orlean founded and served as the first President of the Sonoma County Land Rights Coalition. She also has written several books on these subjects. Her topic: *The History and Importance of Property Rights in Preserving Liberties and How they are Under Attack.*



Debbie Bacigalupi – A rancher’s daughter from Siskiyou County, has a business degree and an MBA from Notre Dame de Namur Name University in Belmont, CA. She also is a certified Meeting Professional and certified Sommellier. Debbie is a former Congressional candidate and is the Northern California Program Director for Eagle Forum of California. She has attended many UN world conferences, and has become a national speaker on Agenda 21, now called Agenda 2030. Her topic is “Seeing with 20/20 vision at Agenda 20/30.”



Erin Ryan – She serves as the Congressional District Representative for Congressman Doug La Malfa; She is also Northern California Vice President for Eagle Forum of California, and she and her husband Bill are hosts of the weekly show “We the People Radio,” on KCNR 1460AM in Redding and online at WeThePeopleRadio.us.
